Charging Using a USB Power Adapter

This product does not include a USB power adapter. Please prepare a commercially available USB adapter in advance. A power output of DC 5.0V / 2.0A or higher is recommended.

- Open the silicone cover on the bottom of the device halfway to access the USB port. Insert the USB cable into the port.
 - Be sure to use the supplied USB cable.
 - · Do not open the silicone cover beyond halfway, as it may detach from the device.
- Plug the USB power adapter into a household wall socket.
 - *As no power adapter is included, please use a commercially available USB power adapter (DC 5.0V / 2.0A or higher is recommended).
- When charging begins, the right-hand indicator above the power button will flash red.

Approximate charging time: 3.5 hours

- · While charging: Flashing red light
- When fully charged: Solid red light









Charging Timing

When the battery is running low, the same indicator will flash red. Please charge the device promptly.

- Once charging is complete:
 - Disconnect the USB cable.
 - Ensure the silicone cover is securely closed.

The device will not operate while connected to a USB port or wall socket.







Avoid performing treatments or cleaning while the silicone cover remains open. Moisture may enter the unit and cause damage.

Getting Started

Skin Sensitivity Check (Patch Test)

To prevent potential skin irritation when using this product in combination with your own beauty gel or skin-toning serum for beauty devices, always conduct a patch test beforehand.

OClean the test area (inner forearm)

- Wash with soap and dry gently with a towel.
- Apply a small amount of your beauty gel or cosmetic to the cleaned skin.



2Apply the product

- Spread a thin layer about the size of the device head.
- If testing both a beauty gel and skin-toning serum simultaneously, apply each to separate areas with some distance between them.



We recommend pairing with a gel developed for beauty devices to enhance your experience.

CAUTION

Avoid using the following types of products:

- Oil-based
- Scrub-type
- · Lotions with warming effects

❸Activate the device and apply briefly (See p.13)

- 1. Turn on the device:
- For cosmetics or sheet masks: Set to "Moist" mode, level 1.
- For beauty gels: Set to "Warm-up" mode, level 1.
- Place the device head on the test area and move in slow, circular motions for approximately 7 seconds.

Check the condition of the skin 48 hours after application

Do not rub or irritate the test area.

In Case of Skin Irritation Within 48 Hours

Discontinue use of the tested gel or cosmetic product.

Begin Treatment After a Successful Patch Test

STEP 1: Remove accessories and contact lenses

- Remove any metallic accessories such as earrings, rings. bracelets, necklaces, or watches.
- Take off evealasses and contact lenses before use.



STEP 2: Cleanse the skin thoroughly

- Perform cleansing or face washing to ensure the skin is clean.
- For body treatments, gently wipe the skin surface beforehand.

STEP 3: Apply gel or cosmetic product generously

- Apply a sufficient amount of product to the entire face, starting from the neck and décolleté area.
- Do not use the device on dry skin.
- If the application is insufficient, you may experience reduced sensation or a slight tingling feeling during use.
- For cosmetics or sheet masks: Set to "Moist" mode, level 1.
- For beauty gels: Set to "Warm-up" mode, level 1.



How to Use the Device

OPowering On the Device

Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds. You'll hear a beep, and the treatment will begin.





When powered on, the EMS level is initially set to 0. so no stimulation will be felt.

- The device will start in Warm-up Mode by default.
- To turn off the device, press and hold the power button again.
- If the electrodes do not make contact with the skin for 2 minutes, the device will shut off automatically.

2Selecting a Mode

Press the button briefly to hear a beep and switch between the three available modes.




- The power button indicator light changes to match the LED color of each mode.
- · Changing modes during treatment will reset both the timer and intensity level.

3Adjusting EMS Intensity

Press the (+)(-) button to customize stimulation strength.



For first-time users or those with ↑ CAUTION sensitive skin, start at Level 1 and observe skin response before increasing.



Strongest intensity: Level 6



A double beep will sound when you reach either the highest or lowest level. Switching modes will reset EMS to Level 0.

Each increase of 2 levels lights up one additional LED.

4 Hold the treatment head perpendicular to your skin.

Apply cosmetics or gel and press the head snugly against the skin.



Refer to "Treatment Instructions" on pages 17-22, and gently glide the device across the skin.



- If your skin begins to feel dry during use, reapply gel or skincare product.
- If it feels too warm, apply more product. If discomfort persists, move the device to a different area.
- Please note: Switching modes during use will reset the timer and return the intensity level to its default setting.

Vibration Guide Feature

To help guide treatment movement, the device gently vibrates every 3 seconds. By default, this feature is off. Press v button to turn it on if needed.



When using the Warm-Up Mode, be sure to turn on the vibration quide and keep the device moving with each 3-second vibration cue.

3 After approximately 6 minutes, the device will beep and power off automatically.

After the session, use your regular skincare routine to finish and condition the skin.



- •Limit usage to two sessions per area per day (maximum total: 12 minutes).
- Allow at least one hour of rest between each session.

Aftercare Instructions

Clean the main unit by wiping or rinsing with water.

To maintain optimal performance, clean the device before and after each use.



- Make sure the device is powered off before cleaning.
- Check that the silicone cap on the underside is securely attached before starting.

• Wipe off any remaining gel or cosmetics from the head with a tissue or rinse with water.

For stubborn residue, use a cloth slightly dampened with mild soap solution, then rinse thoroughly with water.





Do not submerge the device or expose it to running water for longer than 1 minute. $\,$



- Avoid using: Detergents, alcohol-based cleaners, nail polish remover. Use only water or solid soap to clean.
- Be sure to remove all gel or cosmetic residue to prevent damage, discoloration, or cracking.
- Finish by wiping with a dry cloth and let the device air-dry in a well-ventilated space.



Glide the device along the indicated arrows, ensuring symmetrical movement on both sides.



Lift gently in sync with the vibration rhythm.


After reaching point \mathfrak{D} , repeat the process in reverse order. If EMS stimulation feels weak, apply additional gel or lotion to the skin.



Always activate the vibration guide feature and move the device in sync with the on-screen prompts.

Do not hold the device stationary on one spot—this may cause burns.

Training Mode — Approx. 6 Minutes




Lift gently in sync with the vibration rhythm.

After reaching point (9), repeat the motion in reverse order. If EMS stimulation feels faint, apply additional gel or lotion to the skin.



Use no more than two sessions per area per CAUTION day (maximum total: 12 minutes). Allow at least 1 hour of rest between each session.

Moist Mode — Approx. 6 Minutes



Lift gently in rhythm with the vibration.

Once you reach point ®, repeat the process in reverse. When using a sheet mask, hold it in place to avoid wrinkling. Do not force spiral movements over the mask.



Use at a frequency of once every 2 to 3 days. Excessive use may lead to skin discomfort.

Body Care Guide



Can I use the device every day?	Yes, daily use is safe. However, limit use to two sessions per area per day (maximum 12 minutes total), and allow at least 1 hour of rest between sessions. Moist Mode (electroporation) should only be used every 2 to 3 days, as excessive use may cause skin stress.
Are there areas of the body where the device should not be used?	Yes. Refer to page 3, "Areas Where Use Is Prohibited," and avoid using the device on those regions.
Is it safe to use during pregnancy or after childbirth?	Do not use the device during pregnancy. If you are postpartum, breastfeeding, or menstruating, please consult your physician before use.
