Charging Instructions

1 Connect the USB cable to the main unit and the power adapter.



(2) Connect the power adapter to a household AC power outlet.






- Use only the included USB cable with this device. Using other cables or devices may cause malfunction.
- Fully charge the device before first use, after long periods of non-use (3+ months), or if it stops operating.

Using Your Device

(1) Power On







The device will start operating as soon as the power turns on. (EMS level and vibration will return to their default settings.)

The operating mode and heater level will start in the state they were in when the device was last turned off. (If the heater was off when last used, it will restart at Heater Level 1.)

(2) Place on Your Neck


Position the device on the back of your neck so that the USB cable port faces downward.





When the power is on, the back of the Level/Mode dial will light up blue. If the battery is low, the light will turn orange.


You can switch between operating modes by short-pressing the Level/Mode dial. Each press cycles to the next mode in sequence.



Each press of the dial switches the mode.

Adjusting EMS Levels

Turn the Level/Mode dial to adjust the EMS intensity.



EMS intensity can be adjusted in 10 levels.

When the device is turned on, it starts at the default Level 4.


- For first-time use, start at the lowest EMS level.
- If both vibration and heater functions are off and EMS is set to the lowest level, the device may appear inactive. To ensure safety, it will automatically power off after approximately 2 minutes.



If your skin is dry, EMS stimulation may be less noticeable. Apply water or toner to moisturize your skin before use.

Adjusting Heater Levels

Short-press the Power/Heater button to change the heater level.




NOTICE

If you feel excessive heat during use, stop immediately. Prolonged use may cause low-temperature burns. Extra care is advised if you have reduced skin sensitivity.

Controlling Vibration Functions

To toggle the vibration function, press and hold the Level/Mode dial for about 2 seconds.



When to Turn Vibration Off

■ To reduce noise

Turn off vibration when you want to hear your surroundings more clearly—such as during conversations or while watching TV.

■ To relax with gentle warmth

Turn off vibration and set the EMS level to the lowest setting to use the device as a neck-warming heater. Ideal for moments of relaxation.

■ To fine-tune EMS levels


Disabling vibration allows you to better feel the electrical st imulation, making it easier to adjust the EMS level to your preference.

■ To focus on EMS sensations

With vibration off, you can more clearly experience the rhythm a nd intensity of the EMS stimulation.

Managing Guide Voice Features

To toggle the voice guidance feature, press the Power/Heater button and the Level/Mode dial at the same time.



How to Finish Using Your Device

① The massage session lasts for approximately 15 minutes, after which the device will automatically power off

To turn off the device manually during use, press and hold the Power/Heater button for 2–3 seconds.



If the device is removed from your body and left idle for about 2 minutes, it will automatically power off.

(2) After Use

After removal, clean the device. For details, refer to p.16:"Care Instructions and Precautions.



After the treatment session ends, remove the device from your body immediately. Leaving it on may cause skin irritation or other issues.



Cleaning Your Device: Tips and Precautions




Make sure the power is turned off before cleaning. Cleaning the device while it is powered on may result in injury or malfunction.

To ensure safe and effective use of this device, please follow the instructions below carefully.



Wipe the device with a soft, dry cloth. For more stubborn dirt, use a cloth dampened with water and thoroughly wrung out. After cleaning, dry any remaining moisture with a clean, dry cloth.





Gently wipe the electrode pads without applying excessive force. Do not twist, bend, or pull them, as this may result in damage.

The main unit and USB cable are not waterproof. Do not immerse the device in liquid or rinse it under running water, as this may cause malfunction.



Do not use alcohol, paint thinner, benzene, nail polish remover, or other strong solvents. These substances may cause malfunction, discoloration, or cracking of the device components.

Battery Care and Eco-Friendly Disposal

- Charging Time: A full charge takes approximately 3 hours (when using a 5V/1A charging adapter). If the charging time becomes extremely long or short, or if the number of uses significantly decreases even after a full charge, the battery may be reaching the end of its lifespan.
- Note: Battery life can vary significantly depending on usage and storage conditions.
- Recommended Charging Temperature: The recommended charging temperature is between 5°C and 35°C (41°F and 95°F). If the ambient temperature is significantly outside this range, charging time may be extended, or the battery may not charge at all.
- Charging at Low Temperatures: Charging at low temperatures, in particular, may shorten battery life. We recommend charging within the recommended temperature range.
- Initial Use and Prolonged Storage: When you first start using the device (after purchase or after leaving it unused for 3 months or more), or if the device stops operating during use, always fully charge the battery.



Maintaining Battery Life: Lithium-ion rechargeable batteries have a characteristic where their lifespan shortens if left unused for extended periods. Please perform a supplementary charge for 3 hours once a month.

Battery Replacement and Disposal

- Replacing the built-in rechargeable battery requires disassembling the main unit, which
 necessitates specialized knowledge. Do not attempt to replace the battery yourself. For
 battery replacement or disposal, please consult the store where you purchased the product
 or the manufacturer.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or replace parts yourself. Doing so will prevent the device from functioning correctly and may lead to malfunction.

Answers to Your Common Questions

Questions	Answers
Why won't the device power on?	Press and hold the power button for 2-3 seconds until the device powers on and begins functioning.
	The battery may be low. Recharge the device and try again. If the battery level is critically low, the indicator light near the level/mode dial will blink orange and the device will automatically power off.
	The device cannot be operated while charging. Ensure the USB cable is unplugged before use.
Why does the device suddenly shut off?	The battery may be low. Recharge the device and try again.
	When the battery level is critically low, the indicator light near the level/mode dial will blink orange before the device powers off automatically.
	The device automatically powers off if left idle for approximately 2 minutes after being removed from the body.
	When vibration and the heater are off and the EMS level is set to the lowest, the device may appear powered off. For safety, the device automatically shuts down after about 2 minutes in this state.
Why is EMS too weak—or not noticeable?	If the output level is low, turn the level/mode dial to adjust the level.
	The battery may be low. Recharge the device and try again.
	Extremely dry skin may reduce sensitivity. Apply water or lotion to hydrate your skin adequately.
What should I do if EMS feels too strong or painful?	Adjust the output level using the level/mode dial to match your comfort level.
	Ensure the electrodes are in full contact with your skin. Position the device so all electrodes touch the skin properly during use.
	Extremely dry skin may cause discomfort. Apply water or lotion to hydrate your skin thoroughly.
Why is warmth	Adjust the heater level by pressing the power/heater button briefly.
too strong—or not noticeable?	The battery may be low. Recharge the device and try again.
Why won't charging start?	Ensure the charging cable is securely connected to both the power adapter and the device.
	The device may already be fully charged.

Answers to Your Common Questions

Questions	Answers
Shorter usage time despite a full charge	The charging time might not have been sufficient. Please recharge the device and try again.
	If the usage time remains extremely short even after a full charge, the battery may have reached the end of its lifespan. Please contact the retailer where you purchased the product.
Why did the device stop working?	The device automatically turns off approximately 15 minutes after being powered on. Please turn it on again and try using it.
	If the battery level is critically low, the indicator light near the level/mode dial will blink orange before the device powers off.
	If the device is removed from the body and left idle for about 2 minutes, it will automatically power off.
What to do if skin becomes inflamed or painful?	Stop using the device immediately and refrain from using it again until your skin returns to its normal condition. If the inflammation or pain persists, consult a physician.
Can I use the device in the bathroom?	This product is not waterproof. Do not use it in bathrooms or other areas with high moisture levels.
Using the device during pregnan- cy or postpartum	Do not use this product during pregnancy, immediately after childbirth, while breastfeeding, or during menstruation.
Can I use the device while sleeping?	Do not use the device while sleeping.
How should the device be positioned?	Ensure the USB charging port faces downward when wearing the device.
Why can't I hear the voice guide?	The voice guide may be turned off. Please refer to page 14 of the user manual for instructions on turning the voice guide on.
Why does EMS stimulation feel uneven?	Differences in muscle structure or electrode placement may cause uneven stimulation. Variations in skin moisture levels can also create this sensation.
